IE University accommodation options and cost of living for Exchange Students in Segovia

There are four types of accommodation offered which can be arranged for exchange students through the Student Office.

- **On campus:** Reyes Católicos Hall of Residence is located on the campus and provides accommodation for 66 students in the form of 20 single rooms and 23 double rooms, all with a private bathroom, telephone and wi-fi access. Places can be reserved from November 1st onwards. However, they will not be awarded until July 10th. Spaces for exchange students are very limited.

Meals

Prices are per person and include full board. The meal service operates from Monday to Saturday. No meals are served on Sundays or on Bank Holidays. Three meals are served during the day: breakfast, lunch and dinner and students must eat their meals in the student residence dining hall.

Services

All rooms have a private shower and are equipped with WI-FI
Laundry service 2.50€/kg
Washing machine 2€
Tumble dryer 1.50€

- **Renting:** The Student Office works with the best real estate agencies in Segovia to provide information about apartments available and can also help you find a flat to share with another student.

IMPORTANT: Renting options are not available for less than 9 months.

- **Home stay:** For students wishing to spend the academic year in a family environment, IE University can place students with a Spanish family, an excellent opportunity to learn or improve your Spanish.

- **Off Campus:** IE University has agreements with Los Linajes Hotel and Veladiez Tourist Apartments, which offer long-term room rentals and services to students. The first one is located near the center of the city of Segovia and a five minute walk from the University. The Tourist Apartments are located near the university, connected by bus.
