## PRACTICAL MATTERS

<b>Application dates</b>	<b>Autumn semester:</b> 30 <sup>th</sup> of May <b>Spring semester:</b> 1 <sup>st</sup> of November
<b>Semester dates</b>	<b>Autumn Semester:</b> September- December. One week holiday in October <b>Spring Semester:</b> January - May. One week holiday in March NOTE: Examination within the lecture period
<b>Orientation</b>	In the beginning of each semester coordinator organizes an orientation for the new exchange students together with tutors.
<b>Language of instruction</b>	<b>Electrical and Automation Engineering:</b> The language of the degree is 100% English.
<b>English language requirements</b>	A good command of English is needed to study at HAMK as an exchange student. HAMK's recommendation for English language skills is level B2 in The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. Partner institutions are expected to select students who meet these requirements.
<b>Learning Agreements</b>	Learning Agreements has to be attached to the online applications in SoleMove. Those will be forwarded to the departmental coordinator and will be waiting for the student at the start of the semester.
