Course offer	<p>Gdynia Maritime University is the largest state school of higher maritime education in Poland and one of the largest in Europe. Since 1920 the University has been preparing graduates for officer positions on board merchant marine vessels and for managerial positions at the land-based institutions and companies representing the maritime industry and seaside regions. The University four Faculties offer degree in Navigation, Marine Engineering, Marine Electrical Engineering and Business Administration. At present Gdynia Maritime University provides studies for 8000 students.</p> <p>The programs of studies satisfy both Polish educational standards provided by the Ministry of Education and also the requirements of the International Maritime Organization – IMO. Documents required for application	For full study programmes: Candidates for the first year must submit the following documents by the date announced by the admissions commissions of the respective Faculties: The original school-leaving certificate containing an authorization (legalization seal) issued by the appropriate Polish Foreign Service and translated by a certified translator. 1. The document officially recognizing the school-leaving certificate issued in a foreign

	<p>country confirming its equivalence to the Polish school - leaving certificate</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. A health certificate confirming suitability of a candidate to study in a given field. The health certificate should be issued by a certified doctor in Poland. 3. Candidates for marine specializations – an international seamen's health certificate appropriate for the specialization a candidate chooses. The health certificate should be issued by a certified doctor in Poland. 4. Candidates cover the expenses of medical examinations and certificates. 5. A certificate of completing the Polish language course or a confirmation of the Polish Language competence (refers to studies in Polish). 6. A completed form of a personal details questionnaire. 7. 4 photos for passport. 8. A receipt of non-refundable registration fee of EURO 200. 9.
